Environment, Health & Safety

One of our core values at Marioff is to protect the health and safety of our employees, customers and the natural environment we operate in. Our ultimate goal is zero accidents, and we believe that all accidents can be prevented.

We are committed to complying with all laws and regulations, and aim at efficient use of natural resources while minimizing our effluent and emissions.

Visitor Guidelines



- It is prohibited to enter the plant facilities without a Marioff host.
- Visitors must wear a visitor vest at all times when on Kerava factory and warehouse.
- Visitor badge must be worn by visitors on Kerava premises.
- Safety goggles must always be worn in the factory and warehouse.
- Ear plugs must be worn in certain areas that have been marked by the sign of mandatory ear protection.
- Do not touch any products, machine or equipment without your host's permission - we manufacture systems that save lives!
- Photographing is prohibited in the factory premises.
- Smoking is allowed only in the specially designated area outside the factory area.
- Cars are allowed to idle for a maximum of 2 minutes. If the temperature is below -15 C, cars may idle up to 4 minutes.
- Do not enter the plant area under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other intoxicants.

Preventing Slips and Trips

- Do not step off the marked route when walking in the plant area.
- Hold the handrail when walking the stairs.

Sub-Contractors

- All sub-contractors must have a work permit that can be obtained from a Marioff manufacturing supervisor or a specially nominated person.
- Safety training, personal protective equipment and other pre-requisites for the work are defined case by case after the work permit has been granted.

In Case of an Accident

- All accidents, incidents and near-misses representing hazard or harm to the people or the environment must be reported.
- In case of an accident, inform the Marioff host without a delay.

Emergency and Evacuation Instructions



- In case of a fire alarm or other emergency, leave the building immediately and go to the emergency meeting point. ●
- **In case of an emergency, call 112 immediately.**
- Emergency calls are primarily made by Marioff personnel.
